Debbie Garison, a mentor to the same student for over ten years, is the 2017 CISNT Volunteer of the Year! Debbie met her mentee Rubi, now a senior at Lewisville High School, over a decade ago through a partnership with CISNT and North Point Christian Church, where is both attends and works. At the time Rubi was just 7 years old and a second grade student at Central Elementary. When the CISNT team gathered to award Debbie we included Rubi in the recognition. Though she is self-professed to be very shy, she did say over and over to Debbie, "thank you."

Debbie has followed Rubi from 2nd grade at Central Elementary, to Delay Middle School, to Lewisville High School – Killough (oth and 10th grade campus), to Lewisville High School –

Killough (9th and 10th grade campus), to Lewisville High School – Main (11th and 12th grade campus). Debbie has been a constant, positive figure in Rubi's life, walking alongside her for almost her entire academic career. Rubi describes Debbie as a "very kindhearted person who cares for me." Rubi also speaks fondly of Debbie's help through problems both in her personal life and academically and describes conversations with Debbie as a stress relief.

In addition to her time spent mentoring Rubi, Debbie helps organize her church to serve CISNT students at Delay Middle School by providing small meal assistance to the school's student athletes who are unable to afford the required meal plan for participation. She also helps organize drives for holiday assistance and helped organize her church youth group to build a wheelchair ramp at the home of an LISD student.

Debbie is truly the epitome of a person with a "heart of service!" Her consistency and dedication to Rubi is inspiring and we are beyond grateful for her service and excited for her to receive this incredibly well-deserved award!
