

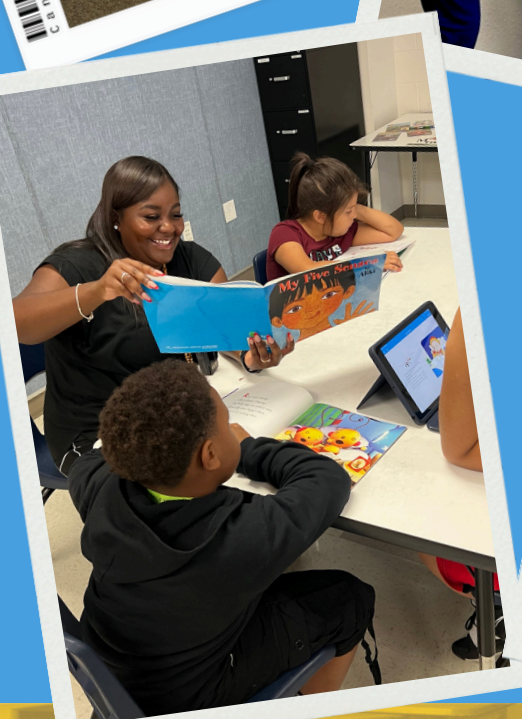

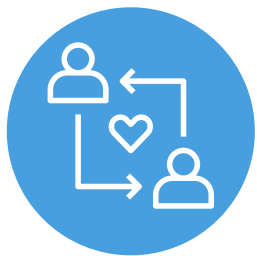

Communities In Schools of North Texas (CISNT) is a community-based nonprofit organization founded in 1993 by a group of community leaders and educators who shared a common concern about the high number of students failing and dropping out of school in North Texas. **The mission of CISNT is to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life.** Over the past 30 years, CISNT has provided holistic services to students in grades K-12 who are at-risk of dropping out of school, helping them stay in school, on track for graduation, and prepared for success in college and their career. CISNT's evidence-based programs provide individualized Integrated Student Supports to best address the unique needs of each student. Through this work, CISNT's vision is to create thriving communities through equitable access to education for all students and families. All CISNT programs are developed with the belief that every child needs and deserves the following five things:



A one-on-one relationship with a caring adult



A safe place to learn and grow



A healthy start and a healthy future

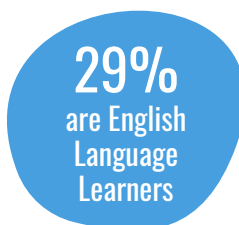
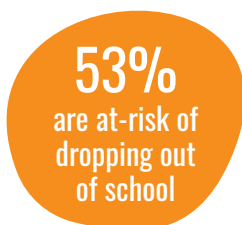


A marketable skill to use upon graduation

The need for CISNT support continues to grow. Increasing, unmet needs of students and families across North Texas indicate the urgency of the need for CISNT to continue to grow to serve students and families lacking the support to graduate high school successfully. In the 2024-2025 school year, CISNT will serve 59 high-need campus communities across six North Texas school districts. Among the students at these campuses:



Each CISNT campus has a degreed, full-time staff member who utilizes a holistic approach developed from research-backed, evidence-proven practices. The CIS model is grounded in child and youth development research and has been found to increase on-time graduation rates while decreasing dropout rates (MDRC, 2017; Child Trends, 2018). Site Coordinators provide case management services in the following **Six Core Components**:

Health & Human Services



Parent & Family Engagement



College & Career Readiness

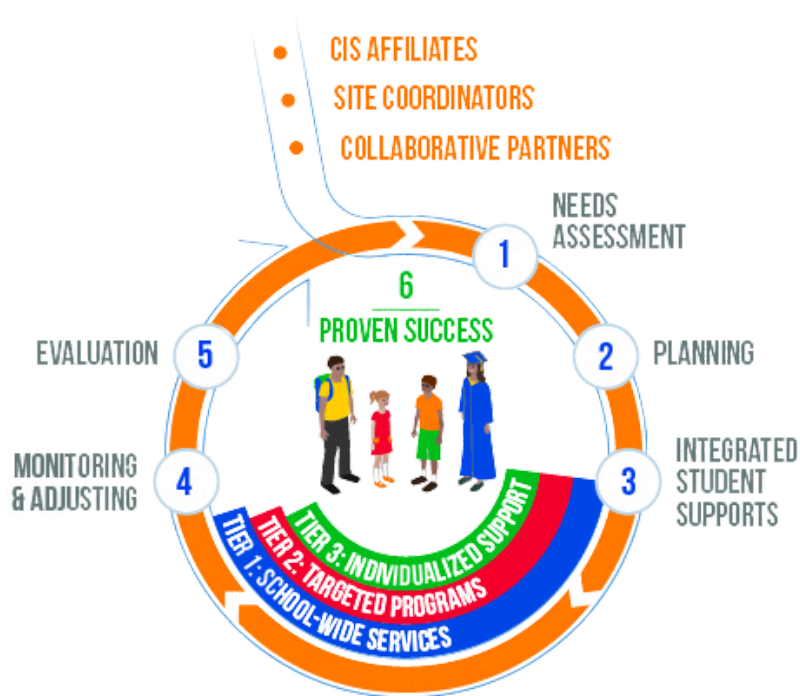

Site Coordinators deliver Integrated Student Supports within these components in three tiers to address the needs of the school, families, and individual students. CISNT programs provide academic enrichment, behavioral support, basic needs support (food, hygiene items, school supplies, clothing), mental health counseling, mentoring, and more depending on a student's unique needs. CISNT's individualized, wraparound supports equip students for success in school and in life.

We amplify the power of each student's potential by connecting them to caring adults and community resources designed to help them succeed. We're by their side every day, supporting them in ways that go beyond the classroom. CISNT brings together a powerful network of partners, including businesses, volunteers, social service agencies, and educators, that empower them with the tools to stay in school and on track for graduation.

In the 2022–2023 school year:



99.9% of students remained in school through the end of the 2022–23 school year



803,390 total services provided by CISNT to students, families, and community members



98.6% of case managed students were promoted



94.4% of eligible seniors graduated



88.6% of case managed students improved in targeted issues



686 volunteers provided **9,768** hours of service to CISNT students



34,565 non-case managed students received school-wide services



5,113 students served in case management program

EMPOWERED TIERED GIVING

Each Communities In Schools of North Texas campus program costs approximately \$95,000 a school year to operate. This includes providing services to at least 75% of the entire school campus. In addition, our full-time degreed CIS Site Coordinators provide tiered support through case management and afterschool programs. Securing funding for a CISNT program is accomplished through grant writing, appealing to private foundations, corporations, and individual donors, and through special fundraising events. **The CISNT EmpowerED Tiered Giving program allows an organization or individual to invest directly in Communities In Schools of North Texas dropout prevention programming.**
